A message from our Head Teacher

What a year it has been... Looking back over the last twelve months since I took on the Headship of The Linden Centres, you could never have predicted the year it turned out to be. From not being able to say goodbye to our leavers last year and having to stay away from centres this year to prevent mixing of bubbles. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all pupils, parents, colleagues and the wider community for their support and ongoing commitment to each of our Linden Centres. It is only because of your support that we have kept going.

Our Spring Term return may not have been all that we had hoped for but we are keen to make sure that each and every pupil continues to do their very best and still manages to get the grades they deserve at the end of this school year.

Reading

The Linden Centre has purchased a lot of new books to enable reading interventions to take place. After testing week has been completed, intervention reading books will be assigned to those that require it. Time with your child's teaching assistant will be allocated to try and improve reading, spelling, grammar, punctuation and comprehension skills. It is really important that children read daily. This needs to be done at



home to assist the work in school and should be recorded in their reading diary (primary) or school diary (secondary). Children will be able to receive Lennon's Linden Loot for consistent reading at home.

We have also purchased a selection of class reader texts. This will allow children to read with others and read for pleasure. Please encourage your child to bring their book home and ready together.



<u>Attendance</u>

Our overall school attendance is 76.58% however removing long term absences, our school absence is 93.17%. This is FANTASTIC!

This demonstrates the importance of school and with a percentage of over 90%, it shows that children love coming to school.

Centre Updates

Primary SS	We recently said goodbye to our last cohort of part timers from the assessment group and these have returned full time to their mainstream schools. We have been focusing on our new intake of children and we can't wait to get to know you all over the next 6-10 weeks.
Primary Specialist	Year 5-6 really enjoyed their topic over the Autumn Term on 'Earth Matters' and had been making planets and painting their own Earth. Year 3-4 thoroughly enjoyed their 'Vikings' topic and finding out lots of facts about The Vikings.

Behaviour points-Lennon's Linden Loot

In September we launched our new Behaviour Points system 'Lennon's Linden Loot'. Students earn points throughout the day based on general behaviour, learning, engagement, quality of work, homework, respecting our values and being positive. Each of these points get collected virtually and on a Monday, students are given their weekly tokens (known as 'Lennon's Linden Loot').

Students can spend Lennon's Linden Loot as if it were currency in our 'Kiosk' or they can choose to keep some to save for bigger items (such as a visit or a half termly trip). We are hoping that students will learn the value of saving however for those that would prefer instant gratification, this is also available.

Christmas Trip
